## **Monitored Child Exchange**

Monitored Child Exchange is a monitored and documented exchange of children between the parents and or guardian. Monitored Child Exchange is useful when there is a Temporary Restraining Order, or when there is no other agreement between the parent/guardian parties for a convenient location for meeting to conduct the exchange.

The location is to be either court ordered location or a neutral location agreed upon by the parents. The individual who will coordinate this service, the Family Monitor will help to schedule the exchange, and suggest to the parties where the exchange may be most conveniently expedited. The Family Monitor also reserves the right to designate an appropriate location to assist client families.

As this is most often a court ordered service, the Family Monitor assigned the case will then document the exchange with information including date, time, and description of the observed and facilitated exchange. Signatures will also be obtained so the parties may have written record of the service details.

## Fee Schedule for Monitored Child Exchange

	Fee Per Each Exchange Time
Standard Fee	\$ 49 per exchange time
Indigent Fee (Court Approved Status Only)	\$ 39 per exchange time
Intake Fee	\$95 per parent/guardian

Upon receipt of completed documentation and court orders, the exchange will be assigned to a Family Monitor who will assist the client family. Then, the Intake and Orientation will be scheduled with the Child exchange details to be finalized. All services are prepaid online at website client pay portal.
