Monitored Child Exchange and Fee Schedule¹

Monitored Child Exchange is a documented exchange of children between the parents at neutral location agreed upon by the parents. The Toby Center reserves the right to designate an appropriate location to assist client families.

The Courts will usually order the exchange; parents may also otherwise agree to exchange location and financial responsibilities through mediation and or other agreements. These agreements will need to be provided upon or before initial intakes for the monitored child exchange service.

COURT ORDERS: Orders including from Marriage Settlement or Other Agreements must be provided at time of request. Temporary Restraining Orders and reasons for them including court related documents must be provided for Toby Center review to determine ability to accept the case request.

When unspecified, or if perceived as dangerous or inappropriate, Toby Center Family Monitor has final approval for monitored child exchange location.

INTAKES: Each parent/guardian will be need to schedule their own separate intakes with the assigned family monitor. Required intakes and related new client forms are available on the Toby Center website, <https://www.thetobycenter.org/client-forms/>.

FEE SCHEDULE

Standard Child Exchange Fee:	\$ 69 per exchange
Qualified Indigent Child Exchange Fee:	\$ 49 per exchange
Initial Intake Per Parent/Custodian:	\$ 120 per party

¹ Fee Schedule for non-clinically supervised monitored child exchange. All fees must be prepaid online. Missed appointments or late cancellation, less than 24 hours in advance, will result in standard child fee payment penalty. Toby Center staff reserves the right to terminate any service, particularly if repeated cancellations occur.
