Child Reunification Agency Awarded \$100,000 Grant

The Toby Center, the HabCenter Boca Raton and the Elizabeth H. Faulk Foundation were the 2022 finalists who received the largest grant awards of \$100,000 each by the The [Men Giving Back!](#) Foundation at a tribute dinner held at the Royal Palm Yacht & Country Club in Boca Raton, Florida. The Foundation offers funding to Palm Beach County nonprofit organizations that focus on children, education, mental health and food security.

The Toby Center grant will provide therapeutic and support services for low income children in South Palm Beach County who both need and are seeking reunification with estranged and alienated parents. Additionally, the grant will provide training and tool kits for school therapists and guidance counselors who will be better enabled to assist children who are struggling in school both socially and academically as a consequence of their parents' embittering divorce and separation.

Founded by Dr. Mark Roseman, CEO in 2010, The Toby Center has emerged one of the largest child reunification agencies in Florida serving a over a dozen counties and child welfare agencies.
